

High School Floor Plans

If you have been in our middle school lobbies, you may have already seen the renderings of the high school floor plans, but we wanted to take a moment to officially share them with you and call your attention to some of exciting aspects of the plans

Science Labs

There will be six science labs in the new building, four upstairs and two down. The four labs upstairs will be outfitted as full chemistry labs, with gas connections, hot/cold water sinks, fume hoods, and a chemical storage/mixing room. The two downstairs will be equipped as physics and biology labs, with cold water access.

Art Rooms

There are two dedicated art rooms located on the first floor. These rooms will feature garage doors opening up into the courtyard to provide natural light, as well as easy access to the courtyard for bigger projects. There is also a door between the two rooms allowing for the space to open up into a gallery for showcases.

Choir/Drama Room

There will be a multi-tiered choir/drama room located downstairs that will hold around 50 students.

Courtyard

On the Cotton Lane side of our building, there will be a large courtyard, sitting in front of the gym. The vision for this space is similar to that of a quad on a college campus, where students can congregate before and after school, and even during school in later years when they have flex blocks. We are excited to see students tossing frisbee, studying with friends, and maybe even taking the occasional nap in the sun after a hard day of work in the classroom.

Learning Commons

On the second floor, you'll notice a large space we are, for now, calling the Learning Commons. This space is designed to be a collaborative space for students that overlooks the commons area below it. For size context, this space is about the width of a classroom at Voyager, and about as deep as two and a half classrooms. Around half of this space you'll notice bookshelves. You'll also notice individual carrels for students to plug in their laptops to do research or finish a paper. This space will also have furniture situated centrally to allow students to work individually or with groups before and after school, as well as

during flex blocks when needed.

Lockers

No more cubbies! Around the hallways you'll notice lockers built in. We aren't positive of the full schematic design, but right now we picture two-tiered, Valor colored lockers for each student.

Gym, Track, Weight Room, Locker Rooms

A major addition to the high school will be a gym. We are working on final details about furniture, scoreboard, and the like, but we do know this space will hold around 800 people in the bleachers and will be equipped for basketball and volleyball. Suspended above the gym will be a three lane track. Attached to the gym is a full weight room and locker rooms for both junior varsity and varsity sports.
